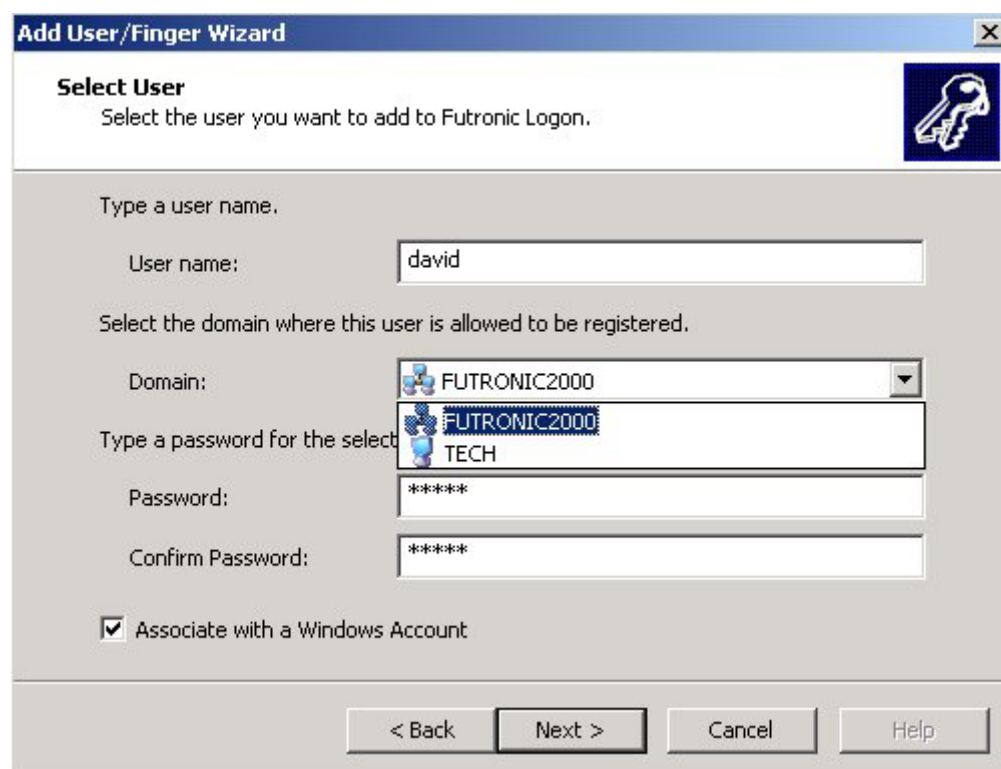
Introduction

If your computer is connected to a domain controller, you can still use the Futronic Logon Software to logon the domain that your computer is connecting to. It is only necessary to select the right domain in the Add Finger/User Wizard. All other operation is the same as that of non-domain user. Please refer to the Futronic Logon User Guide 1.0.

If the Futronic Logon Software was already installed, you should uninstall it before your computer is connected to a domain. And re-install it again after your computer is connected to a domain.

Section 1. Add Finger/User Wizard

If your computer is connected to a domain, a “Domain” pull-down list will appear in the middle of the following Wizard. You can select from the pull-down list to add finger/user to a domain or the local computer.



Add User/Finger Wizard

Select User
Select the user you want to add to Futronic Logon.

Type a user name.

User name: david

Select the domain where this user is allowed to be registered.

Domain: FUTRONIC2000

Type a password for the selected domain.

Password: *****

Confirm Password: *****

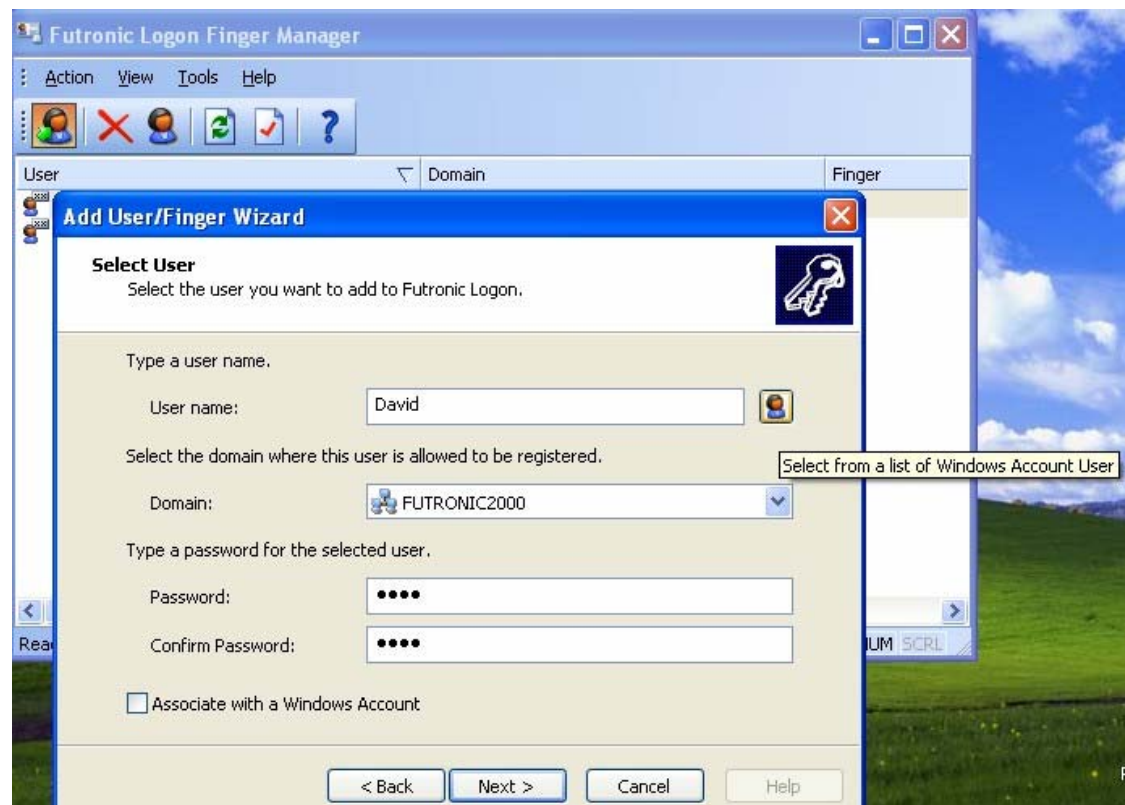
In the above Wizard, the “FUTRONIC2000” is a domain the computer is connecting to. “TECH” is the name of local computer. So you can select to add finger/user to a domain or your local computer. If you select the domain, please check with your system administrator to enter the correct domain user name and password. Please refer to the Futronic Logon User Guide 1.0 for the detail procedure of adding finger/user

Please also note that a domain user cannot run the Finger Manager of Futronic Logon Software. Only the administrator of the local computer can run the Finger Manager.

If you add finger/user to a domain, **DON'T**

1. click the “select from a list of Windows Account User” button at the top right hand corner of the wizard
2. select the “Associate with a Windows Account” checkbox at the bottom of the wizard.

These 2 functions are for local computer user only. Please see the following.



After adding finger/user, the “Domain” property of the added finger/user will appear in the Finger Manager.



If the domain or local computer name need to change, please un-install the Futronic Logon Software before making the change. Then install again after the change. Please refer to the Futronic Logon User Guide 1.0 for the detail procedure of installation and un-installation.

Section 2. Domain User Logon

At start up of computer, you will see the same Logon screen as before. If the finger(s) of domain user is already added, just place the particular finger on the fingerprint scanner, the user will logon his domain directly. If the finger(s) of a local computer administrator/user is already added, just place the particular finger on the fingerprint scanner, the user will logon local computer as administrator or limited user.



If you want to logon by using password, Press Ctrl-Alt-Del to get the "Log On to Windows" screen. But this time, at the bottom, there is a "Log on to" pull-down list so that you can select if you want to logon the domain or local computer by using username and password.
